## Circular Economy

**92%**

of the water used from the River Vienne is returned after 4 to 5 days of treatment in an aerated pond.

**>85%**

of mill energy is generated from renewable biomass residuals, which are by-products of the pulp process.

**90%**

of the mill's waste (such as biomass ashes and pulping chemicals) is returned to the production process or is beneficially reused.

## Our entire business depends on the sustainability of forests

The mill uses a large variety of wood species to preserve regional biodiversity, and our Forest Services group manages over one-third of all FSC® certified forestland in France.



Establishing origin of the wood we use is important. We employ a traceability system to ensure our raw materials meet our standards.



## Our mill is directly involved in the community

Throughout Sylvamo, we strive to support our local communities. Recent examples around our mill include:

- Helping local forest owners in France to attain FSC® accreditation
- Supplying over 105 neighboring farmers with 10,000 tons of ashes to fertilize 10,500 hectares annually, in partnership with Cendrecor
- Partnering with a local ESAT to promote inclusion and diversity in the workplace



## Did you know?

In partnership with World Wildlife Fund (WWF), our forestry team at Sylvamo Forêt Services developed a free biodiversity toolbox to identify needed conservation measures that have helped protect 132 habitats and 2,386 natural species thus far.
